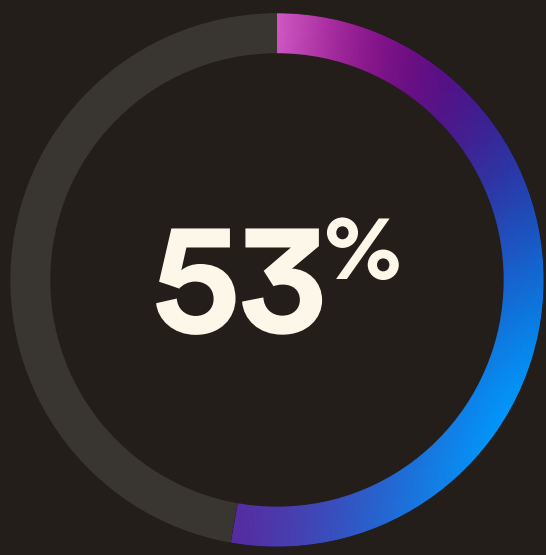
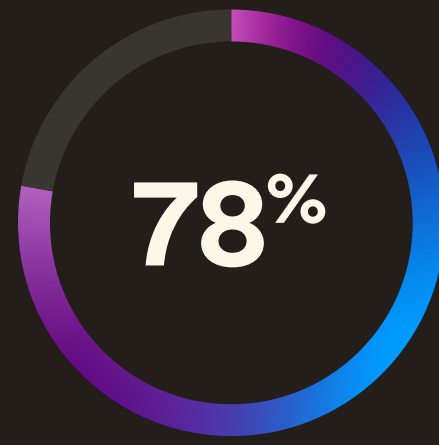


How the STEM World Evolves

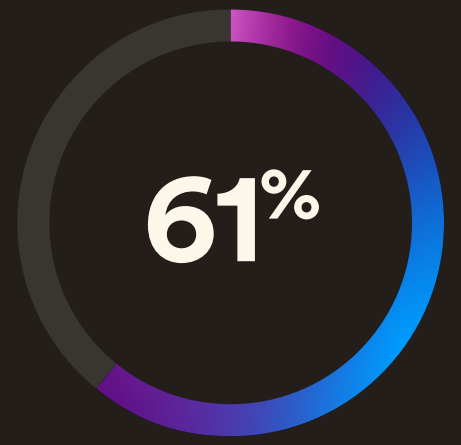
STEM professionals value career security over a pay rise

78% of STEM professionals are satisfied with their **job security**, vs **61%** who are satisfied with their **pay**.



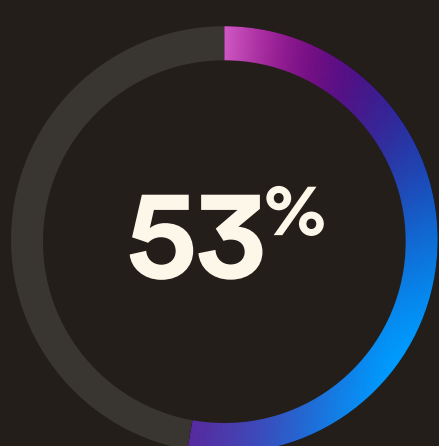
of contractors are unsure whether they will stay or leave their role in the next 12 months.



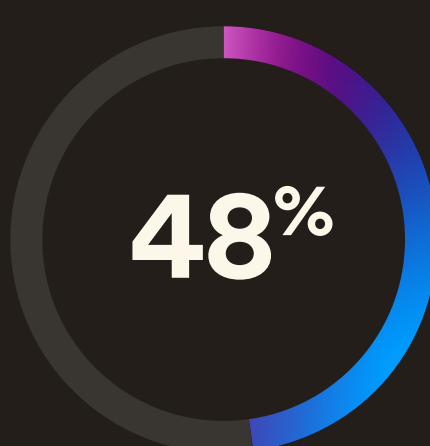
of respondents are unlikely to look for a new role in the next 12 months, with **43%** agreeing that it will be difficult for them to find their next job or contract.

“I have recently had trouble obtaining contracts, and it is hard to remain optimistic that the situation will change.”

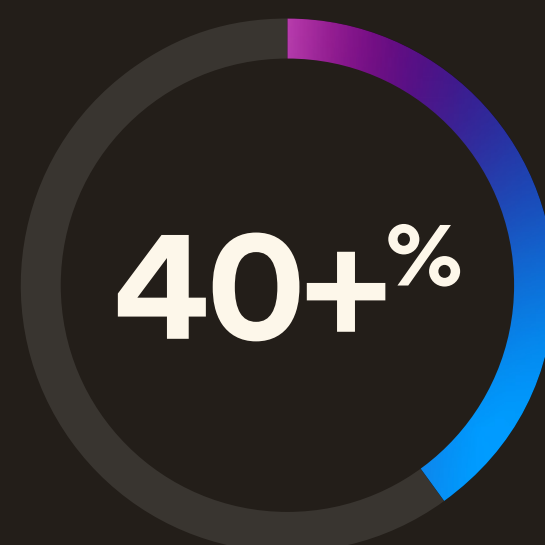
